May 2016 Coffee/Hospitality Ministry Report

The Coffee/Hospitality Ministry provides food and refreshments the first, third, and fifth Sundays of the month after the 10:00 A.M. Mass. The Ministry is active from September till June. This ministry has been funded by parishioner's donations since January 2015. Our current balance is \$26.20.

The Coffee Ministry currently has 18 Volunteers who are able to participate in either coffee set up, service, clean up and/or by donating baked goods and other foods.

This is how the ministry works each Sunday:

- **Set up:** At 9:15 am two volunteers are required to make coffee, set out supplies, sort food donations, and prepare tea and juice. Making tea and pouring juice is done after the final blessing.
- **Service:** Three volunteers provide assistance to parishioners and manage the food and drinks.
- Clean up: Three volunteers remove dishes from the Community Room to the Hall kitchen to clean and put away. Soiled paper and food waste is composted in the community room organics bin. All other recyclables are deposited into recycling bins.
- Baking/food donations: Four volunteers drop off baked goodies or other food donations before Mass.

Volunteers are scheduled under Set up, Service, Clean up or baking for each Sunday service for a six month period. The schedules are listed on the parish website. Volunteers are sent email reminders.

Volunteering is flexible and fun. If you enjoy helping others and meeting your fellow parishioners please join this ministry.
