Mountain Metanoia

Jean Allen

Up on the Mount of Transfiguration, Peter, James and John had a conversion experience. Up until that event they had upended their lives to follow Jesus and believed that he was the Messiah. They spoke with him, listened to his teachings and witnessed miracles of healing and deliverance but up on the mountain their perceptions were shifted and their minds were changed based on new information – in other words, they experienced metanoia.

From where we stand, we know that they didn't receive complete understanding of who Jesus was. They had no idea that Jesus would be crucified and rise from the dead and they spent their journey down the mountain trying to get their heads around what rising from the dead meant. They weren't successful because they still had more conversions and more metanoia to experience. But the experience of seeing Jesus with Moses and Elijah and hearing God's voice in the cloud took them from one level of knowing Jesus to a whole different way of perceiving him. Another piece of the puzzle was put in place.

We can never say, "Been there. Done that. Don't need to go any further." We will never have a complete picture until we go Home and any images and understandings we have of Jesus and the spiritual life will always be incomplete. There are more mountains to climb with Jesus and more moments of revelation where more scales fall from our eyes. But we can choose to stay where we are with the way things have always been for us; God does not force metanoia upon us.

Where were the rest of the disciples in the Transfiguration story? Did they decline to climb the mountain? Were they too tired? Did they love Jesus a lot but weren't looking for anything more or different than what was already happening so said, "Nah. You guys can go. We'll wait down here. Anyway, he probably just wants to pray like he always does. Same old, same old." Whatever their reasons for staying at the bottom, they missed metanoia. They missed a crucial shift.

Just like we will if we decline the climb.

Update and an Appeal from Development and Peace – Caritas Canada,

Before the imminent launch of our next Share Lent campaign, we would like to share a final update on our **Stand for the Land**, which will soon draw to a close.

Our program officer Mary Durran has filed a **field report from Honduras**, from the Guapinol community that the campaign is supporting.

The licence of the mine that has been polluting their rivers has expired, but its powerful owners are lobbying to have it renewed for 30 years. The community, which has opposed the mine repeatedly, unanimously and on pain of imprisonment and death, is now mobilizing to block the renewal of its permit.

They have reiterated their appreciation of Canadians' efforts to amplify their voices, which are still going largely unheard. That is why we need more people to **sign our campaign letter** before it is delivered to the Honduran ambassador to Canada next month.

We are still some ways short of our target of 32,000 signatures, and I am hoping you can help us meet it! Please do all you can to give this campaign one last big push in your parish bulletins, on your website and through your social media channels. Lenten Catholic Mission Feb 26 - 28, 2024 with Fr. Mark Cherry

St. Andrew's Cathedral will be hosting a parish mission led by Fr. Mark Cherry from the Diocese of Halifax-Yarmouth.

The mission will take place February 26 - 28, with an option of morning or evening sessions offered each day.

Morning sessions will be from 9:00 am – 11:30 am

Evening sessions from 7:00 pm – 9:30 pm. Each session will begin with Mass (morning session) or worship (evening session), followed by a talk by Fr. Mark and a time of Eucharistic adoration (days 1-2), or prayer ministry (day 3).

A Canadian Pastoral Letter on Ukraine, Canada, and the Church

February 24 marks the second anniversary of Russia's invasion of Ukraine. 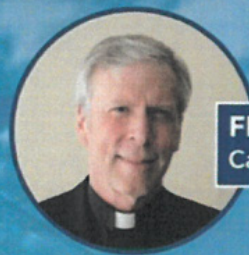
