## Whose Zeal?

It's unfortunate that what a lot of people get out of this Gospel about the cleansing of the temple is that Jesus got mad and, therefore, we are justified in our angry outbursts. That is so not what this text is about. My response to people who use this text to justify their anger is, "When you are as pure, holy and as in touch with Kingdom realities as Jesus was, then you can get angry."

This text is about Jesus's absolute opposition to the whole system of temple sacrifice, not just to questionable marketplace practices. The system of sacred sacrifice presented God as bloodthirsty and vengeful and was set up solely to appease God and turn away God's supposed wrath, not to bring the people into relationship with a loving and merciful God. The cry from God through Hosea, "I would have mercy not sacrifice!" obviously did not make an impact on the temple authorities. What Jesus proclaimed to these authorities was that it was his intention to replace the temple and all blood sacrifice with himself, not just clean it up. It is interesting to note that within 70 years after the crucifixion, there was no more temple sacrifice and hasn't been to this day.

"Zeal for your house will consume me," remembered by the disciples, is from Psalm 69 which is the cry of a person who has been unjustly victimized and subjected to undeserved violence. The psalm also says, "They put gall in my food and gave me vinegar for my thirst." The zeal was not Jesus's zeal because he intended to replace the temple; it was the zeal of the temple authorities to defend their system and it was a zeal that would ultimately consume Jesus. It would murder him. The remembered psalm was a metanoia moment for the disciples.

Perhaps this reflection has offered a bit of metanoia to you as it did the disciples, the shift from, "Jesus was so mad," to "Jesus became our temple, our place of prayer where God welcomes us with love, not vengeful wrath."

A worthy metanoia!

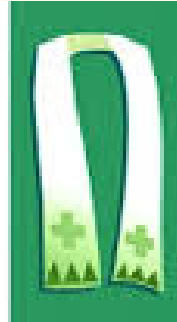

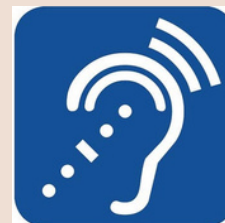

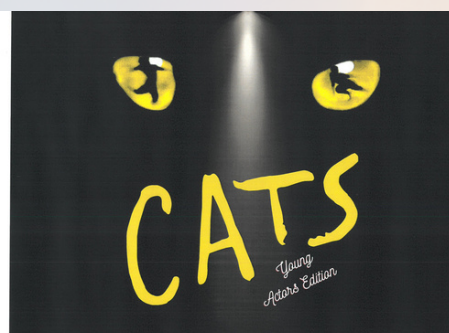

## Update and an Appeal from Development and Peace – Caritas Canada,

Before the imminent launch of our next Share Lent campaign, we would like to share a final update on our **Stand for the Land**, which will soon draw to a close.

Our program officer Mary Durran has filed a **field report from Honduras**, from the Guapinol community that the campaign is supporting.

The licence of the mine that has been polluting their rivers has expired, but its powerful owners are lobbying to have it renewed for 30 years. The community, which has opposed the mine repeatedly, unanimously and on pain of imprisonment and death, is now mobilizing to block the renewal of its permit.

They have reiterated their appreciation of Canadians' efforts to amplify their voices, which are still going largely unheard. That is why we need more people to **sign our campaign letter** before it is delivered to the Honduran ambassador to Canada next month.

We are still some ways short of our target of 32,000 signatures, and I am hoping you can help us meet it! Please do all you can to give this campaign one last big push in your parish bulletins, on your website and through your social media channels. 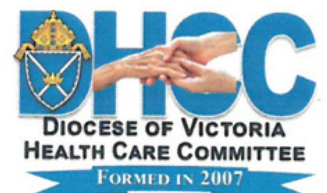
